



REPUBLICANS' RECKLESS SPENDING PLAN WOULD COST NEW MEXICO JOBS AND MAKE NEW MEXICO COMMUNITIES LESS SAFE

There is no disagreement that we need to cut spending. We believe that we need to do it in a responsible way so that we live within our means and can invest in the future, out-building, out-educating, and out-innovating our competitors in the world economy. But as the economy continues to recover from the deepest recession in a generation, we cannot afford to make dramatic and indiscriminate cuts that would undermine New Mexico jobs and public safety. The reckless Republican spending plan would do just that - an estimated 4,300 New Mexico jobs would be lost if H.R. 1 is enacted into law, and thousands of New Mexico families would be less safe.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WOULD DESTROY NEW MEXICO JOBS

- Independent, non-partisan analysis has found that H.R. 1 will cut 700,000 jobs through 2012, with New Mexico set to lose more than 4,300 jobs.
- Nearly 3,000 community health center jobs will be eliminated in New Mexico if the House-passed bill is enacted.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WOULD HURT EDUCATION IN NEW MEXICO, MAKE NEW MEXICO'S WORKFORCE LESS COMPETITIVE

- Under H.R.1, the average New Mexico undergraduate with Pell college tuition assistance will see their assistance cut by more than \$650.
- Nearly 2,000 New Mexico children will lose access to Head Start, an early education program that is proven to help students complete high school.
- New Mexico could lose upwards of \$12 million in job training investments under H.R.1, which would impact approximately 51,000 potential New Mexico workers.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WILL MAKE NEW MEXICO LESS SAFE

- H.R. 1 reduces Byrne Justice Grants for New Mexico by more than \$1 million.
- H.R. 1 reduces New Mexico's homeland security investments by nearly \$800,000, hurting local law enforcement's ability to keep New Mexicans safe.
