How Project 2025 will harm American competitiveness:

The extreme Republican plan would eliminate long-standing bipartisan programs focused on support for American manufacturing and innovation.

- Scales back and even eliminates federal investment in research and development, compromising U.S. innovation and leadership in new technologies, which only emboldens the Chinese Communist Party (CCP). (p. 371)
- Greatly increases standards for antitrust suits by limiting the Federal Trade Commission's (FTC) ability to go after big corporations for bad behavior and protect small businesses/consumers from unfair and deceptive business practices. (p. 872)
- Cuts down on programs that help businesses and trade industries promote their exports. (p. 307)
- Undermines state and local workforce training by eliminating federal investments providing the skills workers need to outcompete the rest of the world. (p. 597)
- Eliminates:
 - Federal economic development funding critical to rebuilding industrial regions of the country. (p. 664)
 - A national network of centers that assist small and midsized American

- manufacturers in increasing sales and creating jobs. (p. 686)
- Key support for American companies looking to grow international markets for their goods and services. (p. 710)
- Federal investment in clean technology manufacturing, ceding these industries to CCP dominance. (p. 369)
- Capital to help American companies export their goods and services to increase sales. (p. 723)
- The Federal Trade Commission, returning its authority to the states. (p. 872)
