



How Project 2025 will harm American democracy:

EXPOSED

The extreme Republican plan would make our elections less safe and less fair.

- Raises FEC campaign contribution limits, allowing the wealthy and well-connected to exert more influence in our elections. (p. 866)
- Blocks common-sense reforms to update the Federal Election Commission. (p. 865)
- Weakens the FEC's ability to enforce our campaign finance laws by removing the Federal Election Commission's independent litigating authority. (p. 865)
- Reclassifies thousands of civil servants as political appointees allowing for the hiring of federal government roles based on partisan ideology, not competency. (p. 21)
- Compromises the decennial census process, threatening to weaken representation for millions of Americans. (p. 680)
- Expands presidential powers by placing the entire federal bureaucracy under direct control of the President. (p. 44)
- Ends and defunds public media (like the Public Broadcasting Service) and National Public Radio (NPR). (p. 247)

- Calls on DOJ to use all tools to rescind guidance by Attorney General Merrick Garland that helps investigators combat unauthorized leaks to media—potentially harming ongoing investigations. (p. 214)
- Suggests that the President can order federal agencies to refuse to spend money Congress has appropriated for programs the President opposes. (p. 47)
- Injects partisanship into nonpartisan federal agencies like the DOJ and FEC (which are vital for ensuring our elections remain free and fair) by forcing them to directly answer to the President. (p. 20)
- Calls for the President to use federal agencies and Congress to undo the previous administration's policies. (p. 50)
