



## How Project 2025 will harm education:

EXPOSED

The extreme Republican plan would eliminate the Department of Education and decimate our public education system.

- Abolishes the Department of Education in its entirety. (p. 319)
- Eliminates Head Start which provides early learning, health, nutrition, and family support services for nearly 1 million low-income children and their families every year – all as the country undergoes a critical child care crisis. (p. 482)
- Wipes out universal free school meal programs, including summer meal programs. (p. 303)
- Defunds public schools and instead funnels tax-payer dollars to fund unaccountable private schools. (p. 319)
- Phases out Title I Funding –funding for high-poverty schools – which would cut 180,000 teacher positions, by <u>some</u> <u>estimates</u>. (pp. 325-326)
- Eliminates the rights of children with disabilities to receive Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) under IDEA. (p. 326)
- Guts Title IX protections for campus sexual assault survivors and weakens protections for LGBTQ+ students. (p. 331)

- Ends student loan forgiveness programs including for our veterans, nurses, teachers, law enforcement officials, and other public servants. (p. 354)
- Ends all current income-driven repayment plans – which calculate monthly student loan payments based on income –further burdening students with sky-high student loans. (p. 331)
- Privatizes all student loans hiking up interest rates and forcing students to take on predatory loans for their education. (p. 353)
- Promotes efforts to ban books and censor the rights of students to learn accurate American history. (p. 343)
