How Project 2025 will strip away health care:

The extreme Republican plan would make health care less affordable and more restrictive for tens of millions of Americans.

- Ends Medicare's power to negotiate drug prices, raising costs for common and expensive drugs. This affects about 9 million seniors who currently pay nearly \$3.5 billion per year out-of-pocket for 10 drugs without the negotiated prices.
- Repeals the \$2,000 annual limit on out-of-pocket drug costs for Medicare, sending seniors back to the days when a single drug could cost a patient more than \$10,000 and one-in-five seniors reported forgoing medication, skipping doses or cutting pills in half because they could not afford their drugs.
- Repeals the \$35 insulin cap for Medicare, once again asking seniors to pay hundreds of dollars each month for their insulin.
- Ends enhanced ACA premium assistance, nearly doubling premiums on average for millions of Americans. Under Democrats, the ACA nearly doubled its total enrollment in the past four years and the uninsured rate hit its lowest point in the country's history.

- Decimates Medicaid funding, putting coverage and health care at risk for more than 80 million low-income Americans, threatening the financial stability of the hospitals, doctors and health centers who serve those patients.
- Eliminates free vaccines, such as shingles and pneumonia shots, for 52 million people on Medicare.
- Re-instates pharma's ability to price gouge and raise drug prices each year far above inflation without any penalty.
