How Project 2025 will halt legal immigration and harm border security:

The extreme Republican plan would devastate the economy, encourage unlawful immigration, separate families, and make our country less safe.

- Funds the ineffective border wall. (pp. 147, 555)
- Terminates DACA, making Dreamers vulnerable to deportation. (p. 145)
- Paves the way for mass deportations and separation of families. (pp. 141-143, 148, 150-151, & 568)
- Jeopardizes national security by redirecting the U.S. military to build the border wall and enforce immigration laws on U.S. soil. (pp. 144-147)
- Encourages unlawful immigration by halting the legal immigration system through new and insurmountable backlogs that will harm the U.S. economy. (pp. 144-147)
- Authorizes ICE agents to raid schools, hospitals, daycares, and churches. (pp. 142 & 152)
- Stops border agencies from safe and orderly processing at the border, harming border security and creating inhumane open-air camps. (pp. 140 & 151)
- Harms the economy by creating a brain drain of foreign students with advanced degrees educated at U.S. colleges. (p. 167)

- Ceases the U.S. refugee program by reassigning State Department vetting staff. (p. 178)
- Ends the use of parole authorities leading to a dramatic increase in the number of border crossings. (pp. 146, 149 & 151)
- Eliminates prosecutorial discretion that helps ICE prioritize resources to deport criminals and those who present a danger to the public. (pp. 150 & 151)
- Balloons the ICE budget by hundreds of billions of tax-payer dollars to wastefully detain all immigrants, including families and those presenting no risk, enriching prison contractors. (pp. 141, 143, 150 & 151)
- Eliminates asylum immediately by re-enacting bans that were previously invalidated by federal courts as unlawful. (pp. 145 & 148)
- Ends the Flores Settlement Agreement and its protections for children to house families and children in large-scale ICE detention camps. (pp. 148 & 568)
