How Project 2025 will harm veterans:

The extreme Republican plan would harm veterans and undermine the support the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) provides to veterans.

- Ends access to reproductive healthcare supported by the VA, dictating what kinds of care veterans can receive. (p. 642)
- Encourages more private companies to get involved with disability medical examinations, opening the door to more for-profit companies who may prey on vulnerable veterans. (p. 650)
- Recommends closure of the Office of Accountability and Whistleblower Protection, weakening VA employee and supervisor accountability. (p. 653)
- Locks in out-of-date policies that dictate when and how veterans can access care outside of the VA system, ignoring the changing demographics and needs of the veteran population and the VA's ability to care for all veterans. (p. 645)

■ Threatens return of the AIR Commission that recommended closure of key facilities, including standalone VA hospitals that communities rely on. (p. 646))
