



REPUBLICANS' RECKLESS SPENDING PLAN WOULD COST NEVADA JOBS AND MAKE NEVADA COMMUNITIES LESS SAFE

There is no disagreement that we need to cut spending. We believe that we need to do it in a responsible way so that we live within our means and can invest in the future, out-building, out-educating, and out-innovating our competitors in the world economy. But as the economy continues to recover from the deepest recession in a generation, we cannot afford to make dramatic and indiscriminate cuts that would undermine Nevada jobs and public safety. The reckless Republican spending plan would do just that - an estimated 6,000 Nevada jobs would be lost if H.R. 1 is enacted into law, and thousands of Nevada families would be less safe.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WOULD DESTROY NEVADA JOBS

- Independent, non-partisan analysis has found that H.R. 1 will cut 700,000 jobs through 2012, with Nevada set to lose nearly 6,000 jobs.
- Nearly 600 community health center jobs will be eliminated in Nevada if the House-passed bill is enacted.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WOULD HURT EDUCATION IN NEVADA, MAKE NEVADA'S WORKFORCE LESS COMPETITIVE

- Under H.R.1, the average Nevada undergraduate with Pell college tuition assistance will see their assistance cut by more than \$600.
- More than 800 Nevada children will lose access to Head Start, an early education program that is proven to help students complete high school.
- Nevada could lose upwards of \$30 million in job training investments under H.R.1, which would impact approximately 8,000 potential Nevada workers.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WILL MAKE NEVADA LESS SAFE

- H.R. 1 reduces Byrne Justice Grants for Nevada by \$1.6 million.
- H.R. 1 reduces Nevada's homeland security investments by nearly \$1 million, hurting local law enforcement's ability to keep Nevadans safe.
