



REPUBLICANS' RECKLESS SPENDING PLAN WOULD COST OKLAHOMA JOBS AND MAKE OKLAHOMA COMMUNITIES LESS SAFE

There is no disagreement that we need to cut spending. We believe that we need to do it in a responsible way so that we live within our means and can invest in the future, out-building, out-educating, and out-innovating our competitors in the world economy. But as the economy continues to recover from the deepest recession in a generation, we cannot afford to make dramatic and indiscriminate cuts that would undermine Oklahoma jobs and public safety. The reckless Republican spending plan would do just that - an estimated 8,300 Oklahoma jobs would be lost if H.R. 1 is enacted into law, and thousands of Oklahoma families would be less safe.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WOULD DESTROY OKLAHOMA JOBS

- Independent, non-partisan analysis has found that H.R. 1 will cut 700,000 jobs through 2012, with Oklahoma set to lose more than 8,300 jobs.
- More than 1,000 community health center jobs will be eliminated in Oklahoma if the House-passed bill is enacted.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WOULD HURT EDUCATION IN OKLAHOMA, MAKE OKLAHOMA'S WORKFORCE LESS COMPETITIVE

- Under H.R.1, the average Oklahoma undergraduate with Pell college tuition assistance will see their assistance cut by nearly \$700.
- Nearly 3,500 Oklahoma children will lose access to Head Start, an early education program that is proven to help students complete high school.
- Oklahoma could lose more than \$20 million in job training investments under H.R.1, which would impact approximately 160,000 potential Oklahoma workers.

REPUBLICAN SPENDING PLAN WILL MAKE OKLAHOMA LESS SAFE

- H.R. 1 reduces Byrne Justice Grants for Oklahoma by \$1.8 million.
- H.R. 1 reduces Oklahoma's homeland security investments by nearly \$800,000, hurting local law enforcement's ability to keep Oklahoma families safe.
